Installation Preparation - 1.3

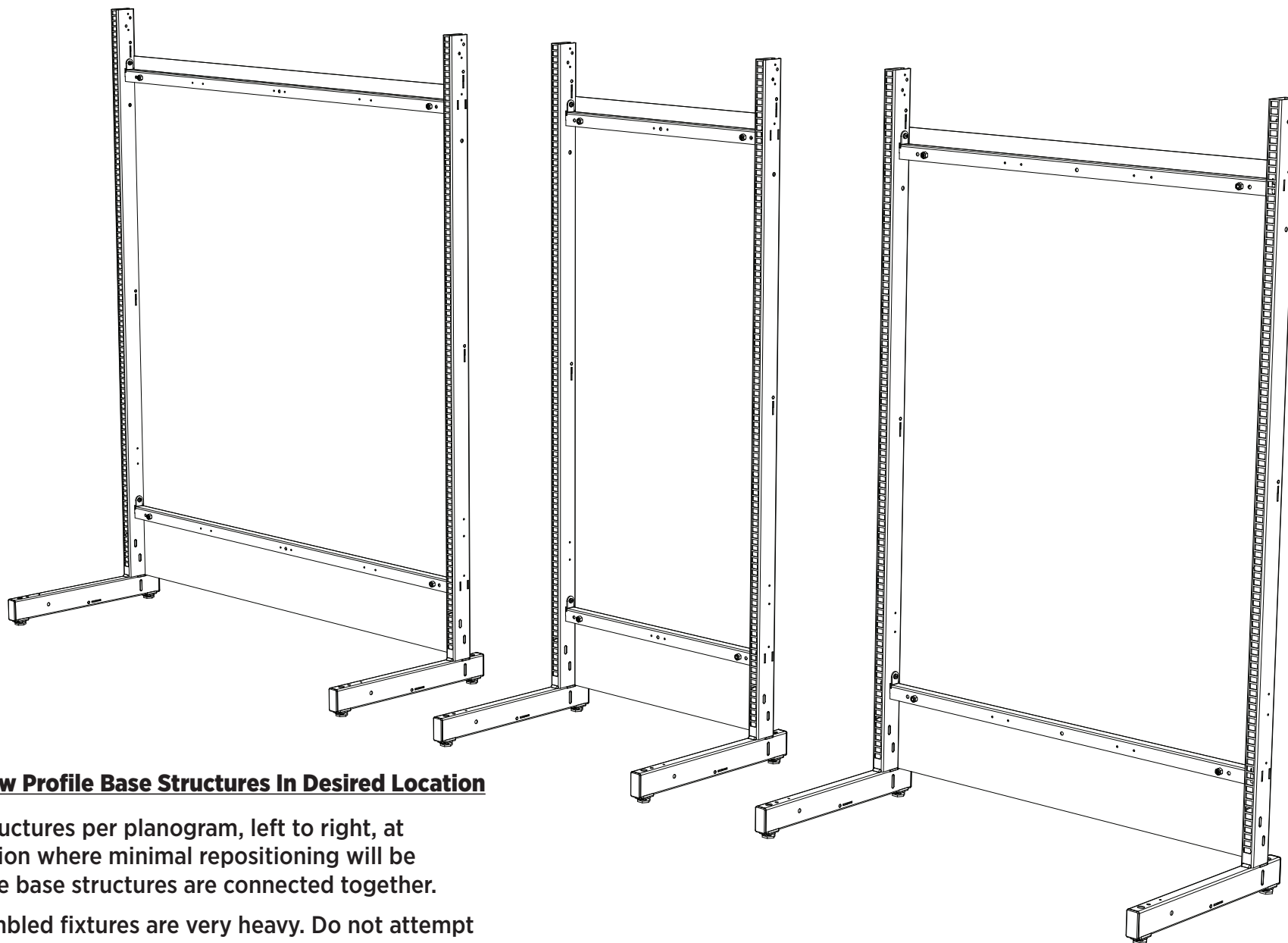
STEP 2: Remove Top Sign And Shelves From Base Structure

- Remove Top Sign Cover and set aside (it is not attached).
- Pivot rotating locks on both Top Sign side brackets, away from the slots in uprights, to unlock. (DETAIL 2A and 2B)
- Grip side brackets of Top Sign, lift directly upward to release from slots, then tilt entire Top Sign assembly toward the back of the structure to remove it from uprights. (DETAIL 2C)
- Set Top Sign structure aside until instructed to reinstall.
- Unlock both rotating locks at the back of each shelf, and remove all shelves from Low Profile Base Structure in the same manner. (DETAIL 2C)
- Set shelves aside until instructed to reinstall.

STEP 3: Place Low Profile Base Structures In Desired Location

Arrange base structures per planogram, left to right, at installation location where minimal repositioning will be required once the base structures are connected together.

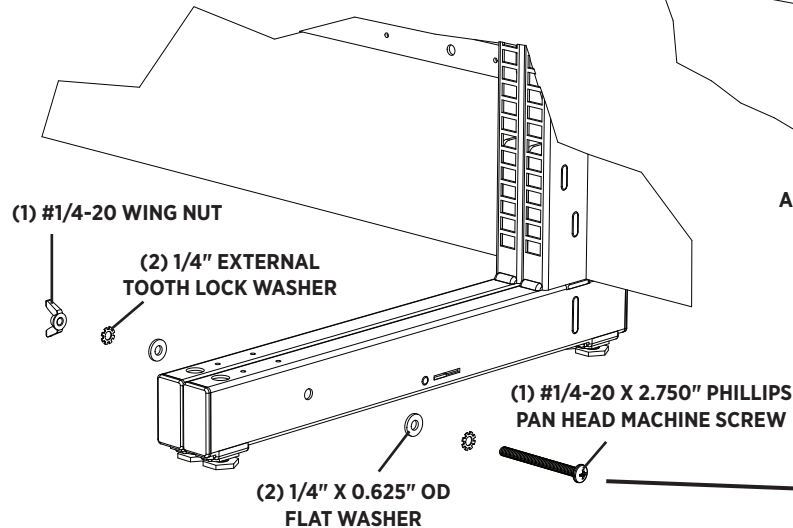

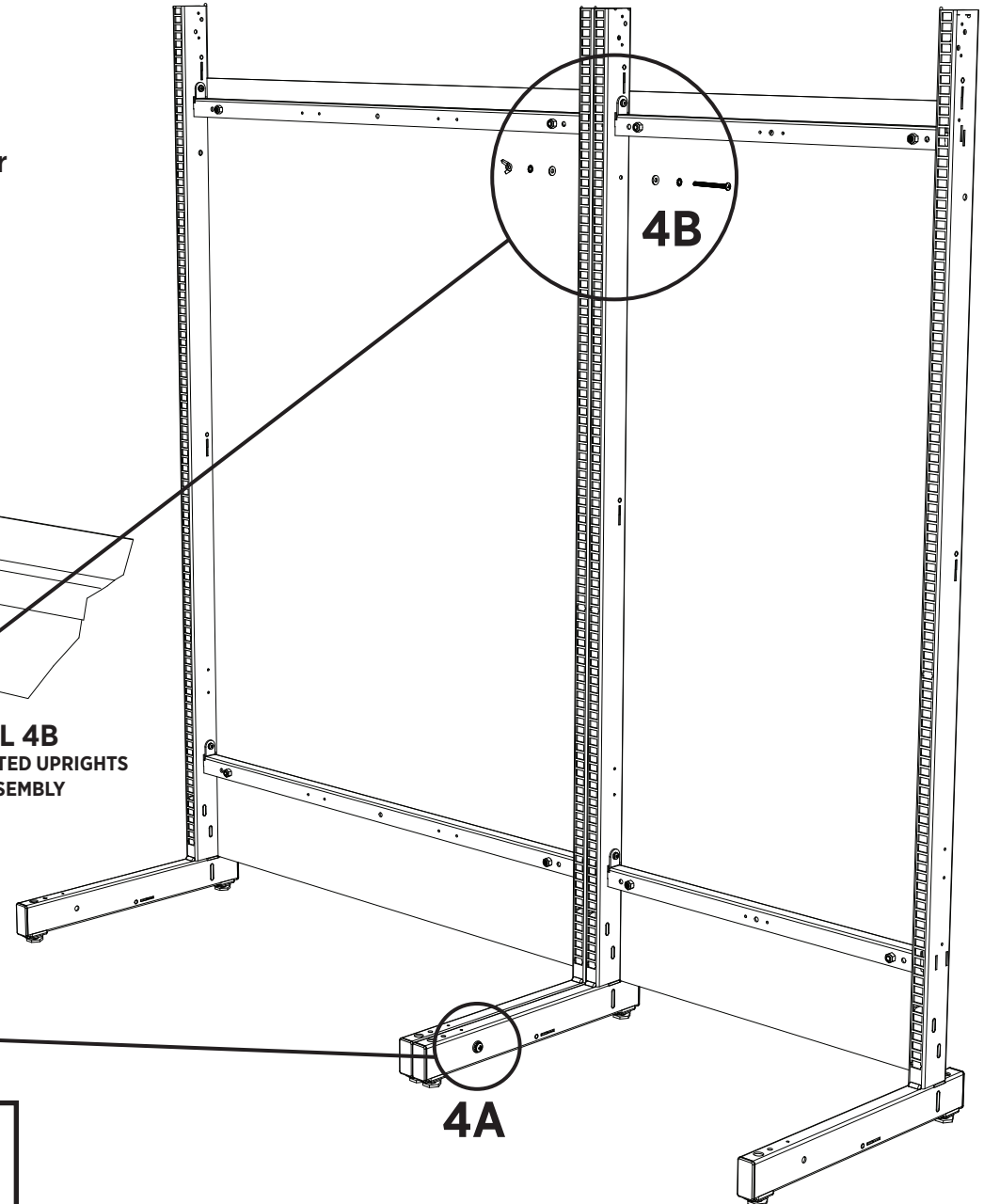
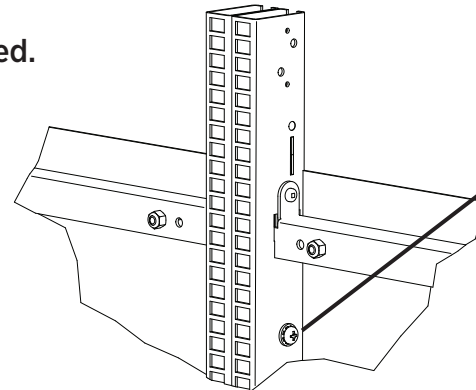
STEP 4: Connect Low Profile Base Structures Together

- Connect adjacent horizontal legs together using **(DETAIL 4A)**:
 - (1) #1/4-20 x 2.750" Phillips Pan Head Machine Screw
 - (2) 1/4" External Tooth Lock Washers
 - (2) 1/4" x 0.625" OD Flat Washers
 - (1) #1/4-20 Wing Nut
- Connect adjacent slotted uprights together in the same manner **(DETAIL 4B)**:
 - (1) #1/4-20 x 2.750" Phillips Pan Head Machine Screw
 - (2) 1/4" External Tooth Lock Washers
 - (2) 1/4" x 0.625" OD Flat Washers
 - (1) #1/4-20 Wing Nut
- Repeat hardware installation as required.

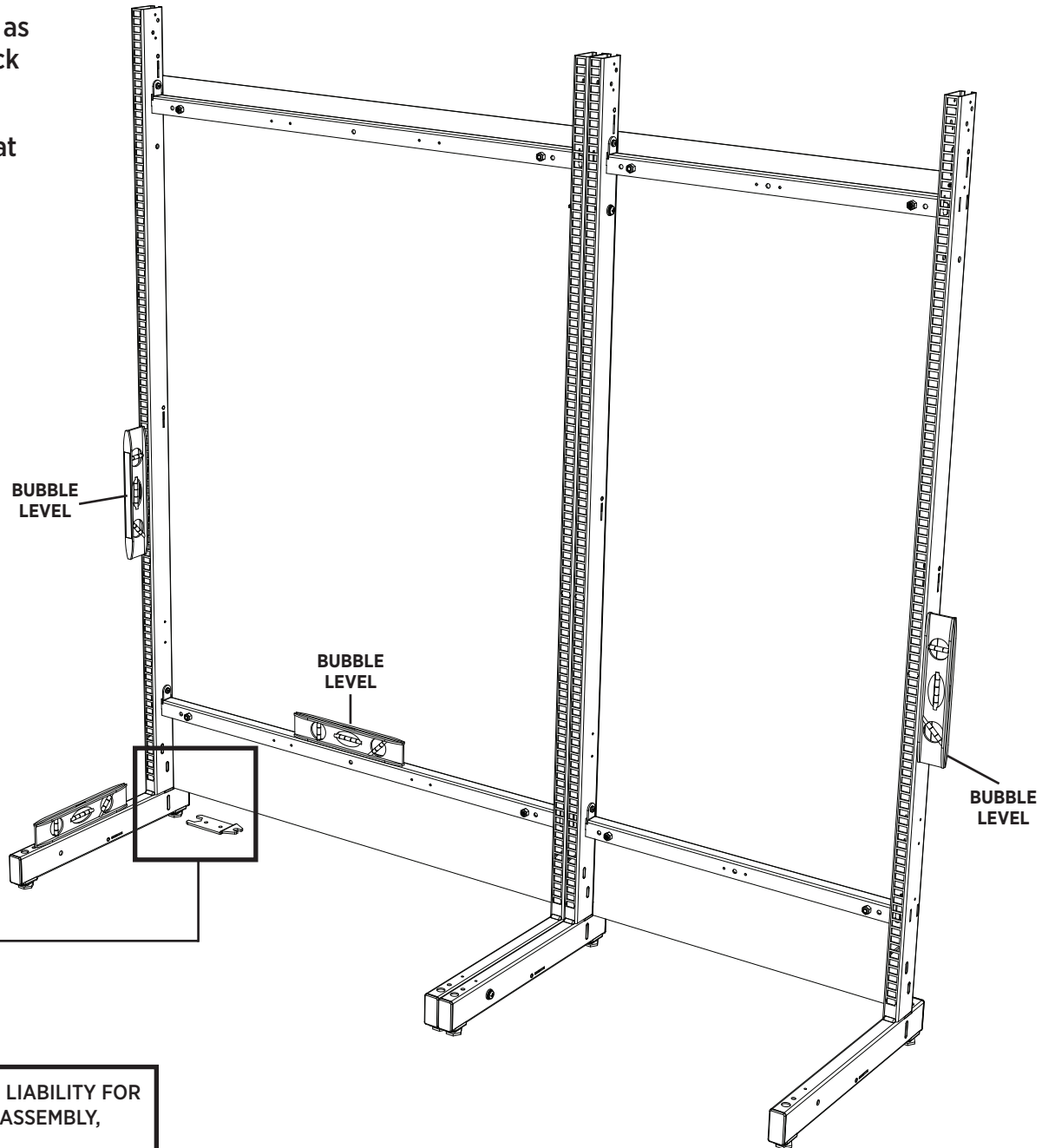
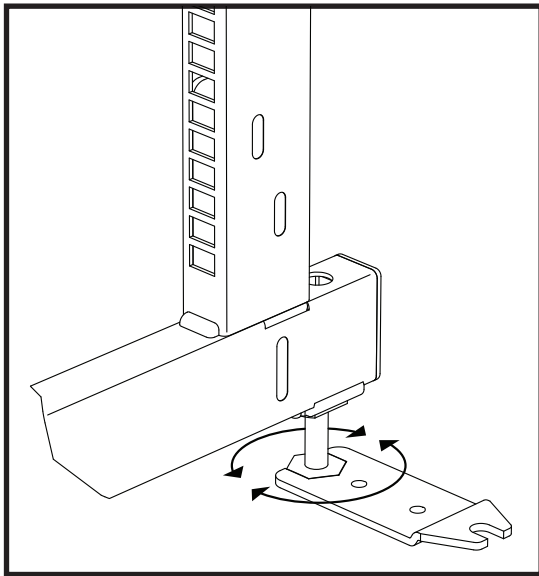
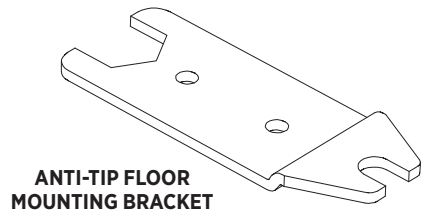

STEP 5: Level & Align Low Profile Base Structure Assembly

Use the hex end of an Anti-Tip Floor Mounting Bracket as a wrench to adjust levelers located at the front and back each support leg, as shown.

Use bubble level in each section of display to check that the entire structure is level front to back, horizontally and vertically.

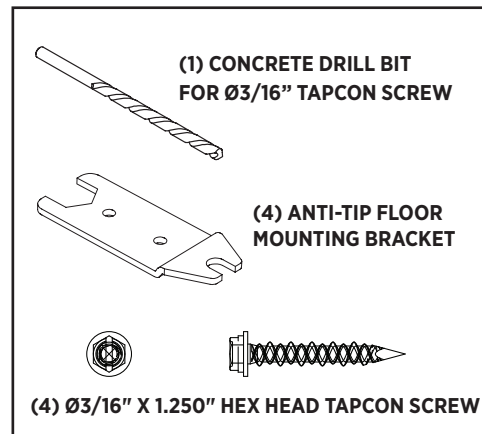
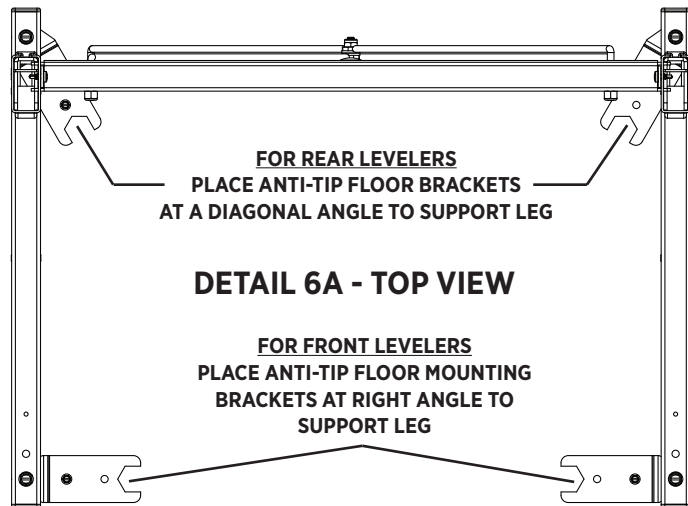

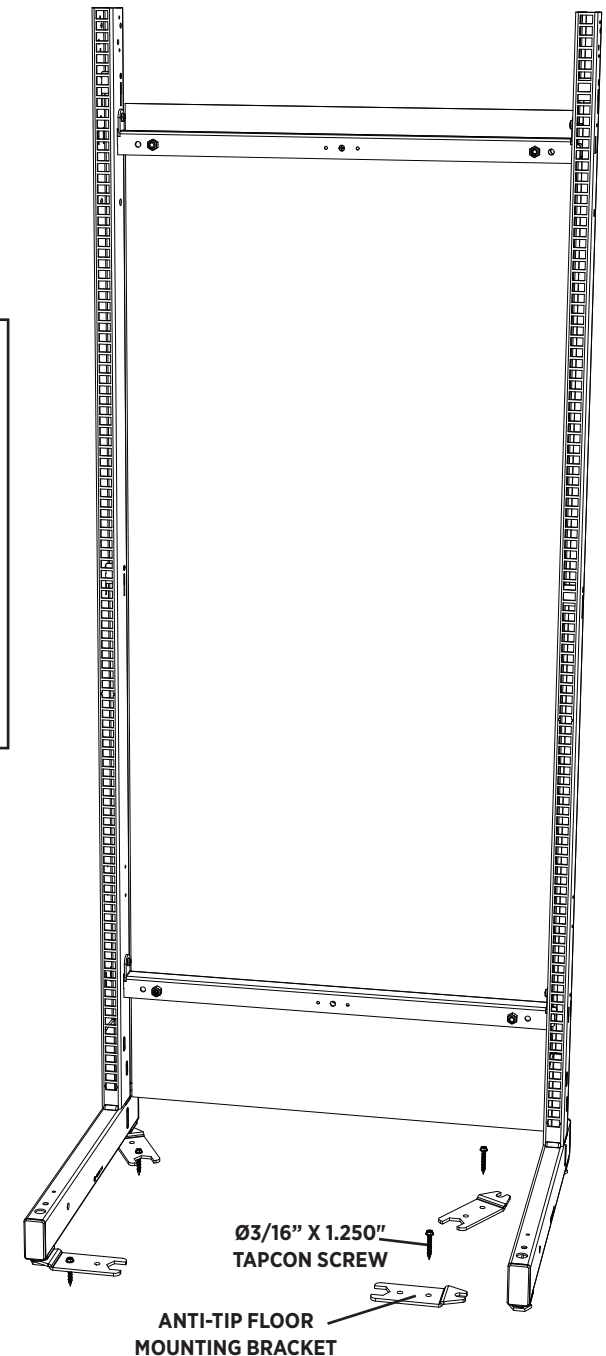
STEP 6: Install Anti-Tip Floor Brackets To Base Structure

For safety and stability, Anti-Tip Floor Mounting Brackets must be installed over every leveler in the base structural assembly. **Refer to DETAIL 6A for correct placement and positioning of Anti-Tip Floor Mounting Brackets.**



- Use the provided 3/16" concrete drill bit. Place one (1) Anti-Tip Floor Bracket over leveler, using one of the holes as a guide to drill a 1.25" deep hole into concrete floor.
- Install one (1) Ø3/16" x 1.250" Tapcon Screw through hole in bracket and into concrete floor.
- Use a 1/4" hex driver to drive Tapcon Screws into concrete floor.
- Repeat installation over all levelers in structural assembly.

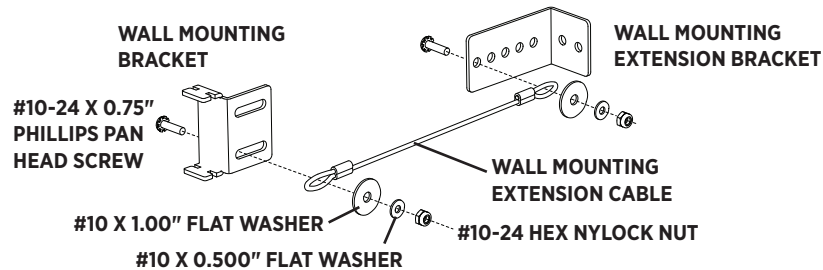

STEP 7: Assemble And Install Wall Mount Brackets

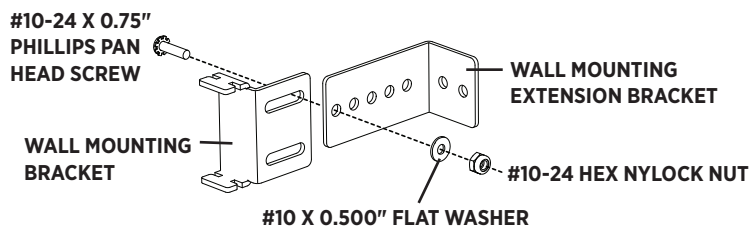
For safety and stability, Wall Mount Brackets must be attached to the base unit at the far left and far right vertical leg uprights, and to one of the vertical legs at each location where two vertical legs have been connected together throughout the assembly.

- Measure the distance from vertical leg uprights to the wall, and determine bracket assembly needed to span the gap. Preassemble the required number of bracket sets prior to installation.

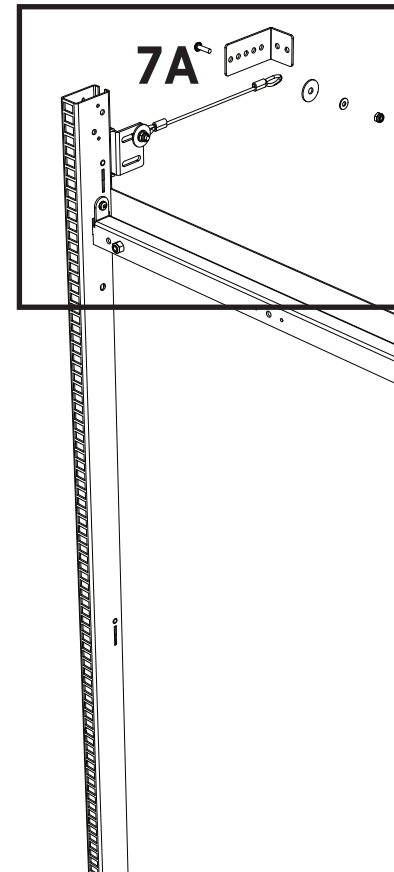
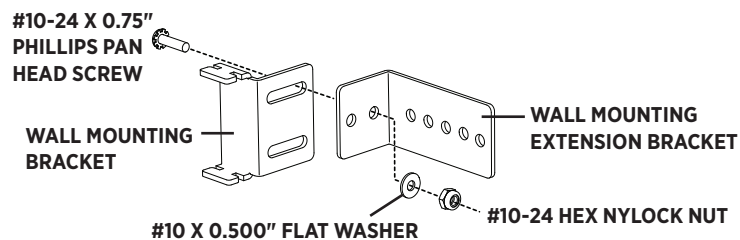
ASSEMBLY #1: IF VERTICAL LEG UPRIGHT IS 2.5" - 11" FROM WALL



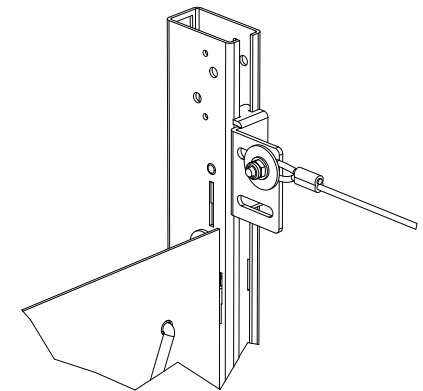
ASSEMBLY #2: IF VERTICAL LEG UPRIGHT IS 1" - 2.5" FROM WALL

- Slide bracket assemblies into the open channel on back side of far left & far right leg uprights and into one leg of each connected leg pair (**DETAIL 7A**).
- **IMPORTANT:** Wall mounting screws and related hardware are NOT included in this kit. Determine the correct wall mounting hardware that will secure the Wall Mount Bracket assemblies to the existing wall type at installation location to securely support the structural assembly. Install wall mounting hardware as required.

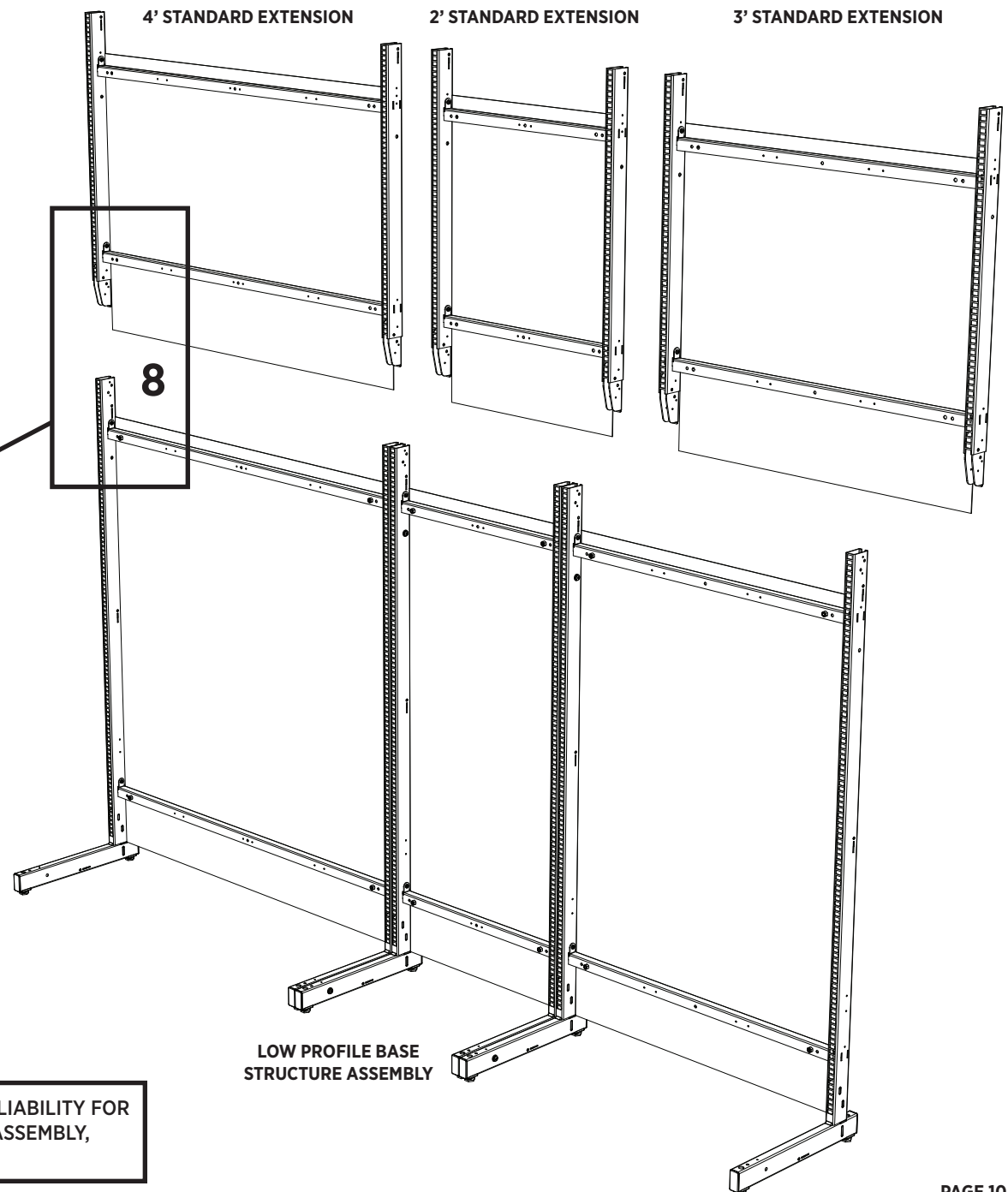
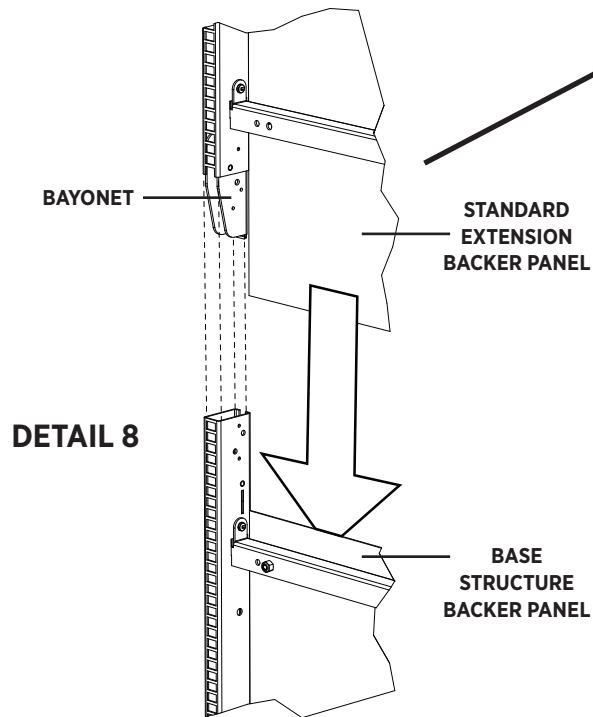

STEP 8: Install Standard Extensions Onto Low Profile Base Structure Assembly

After the Low Profile Base Structure has been secured to the floor and wall, install Standard Extensions.

- Begin at one end of the Base Structure, and carefully slide bayonets of each corresponding width Standard Extension into the open top of each leg upright.
- **IMPORTANT:** Make sure that backer panel on the Standard Extension **slides behind** the backer panel on Base Structure (**DETAIL 8**).

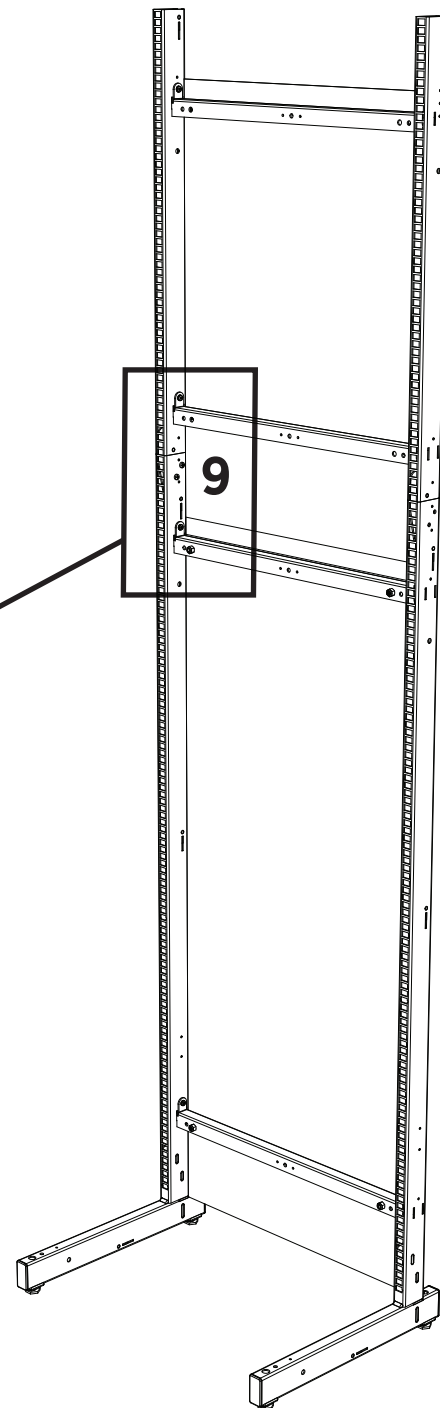
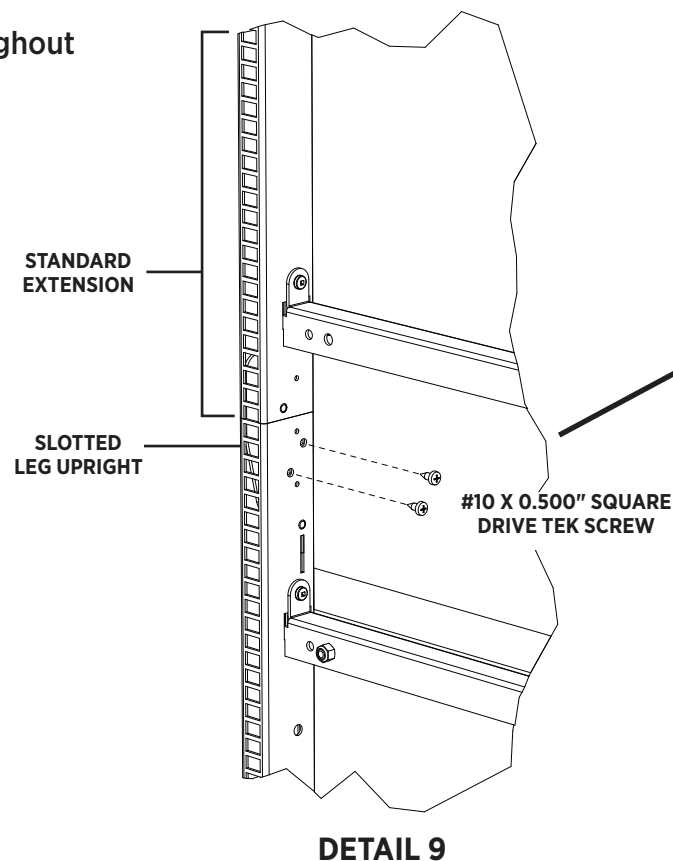
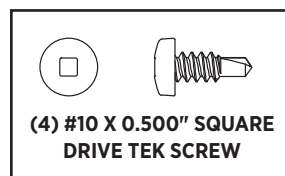

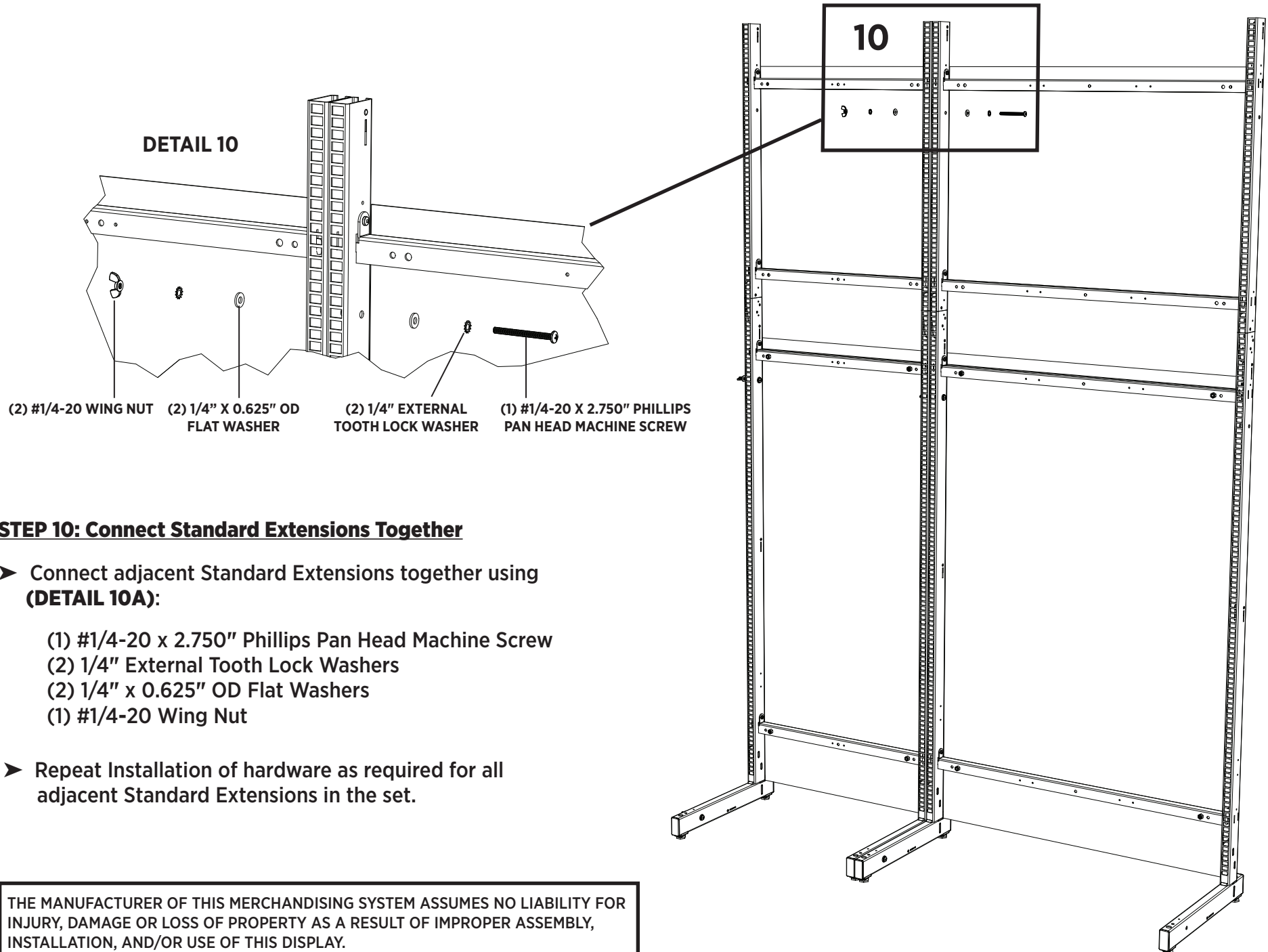
STEP 9: Secure Standard Extensions To Low Profile Base Structure

- Note location of screw holes in sides of slotted leg uprights. Install two (2) #10 x 0.500" Square Drive TEK Screws into holes in slotted leg upright at each connection point where the Standard Extensions have been inserted into the Low Profile Base Structure (**DETAIL 9**).
- Repeat above step as required throughout the Structural Assembly.

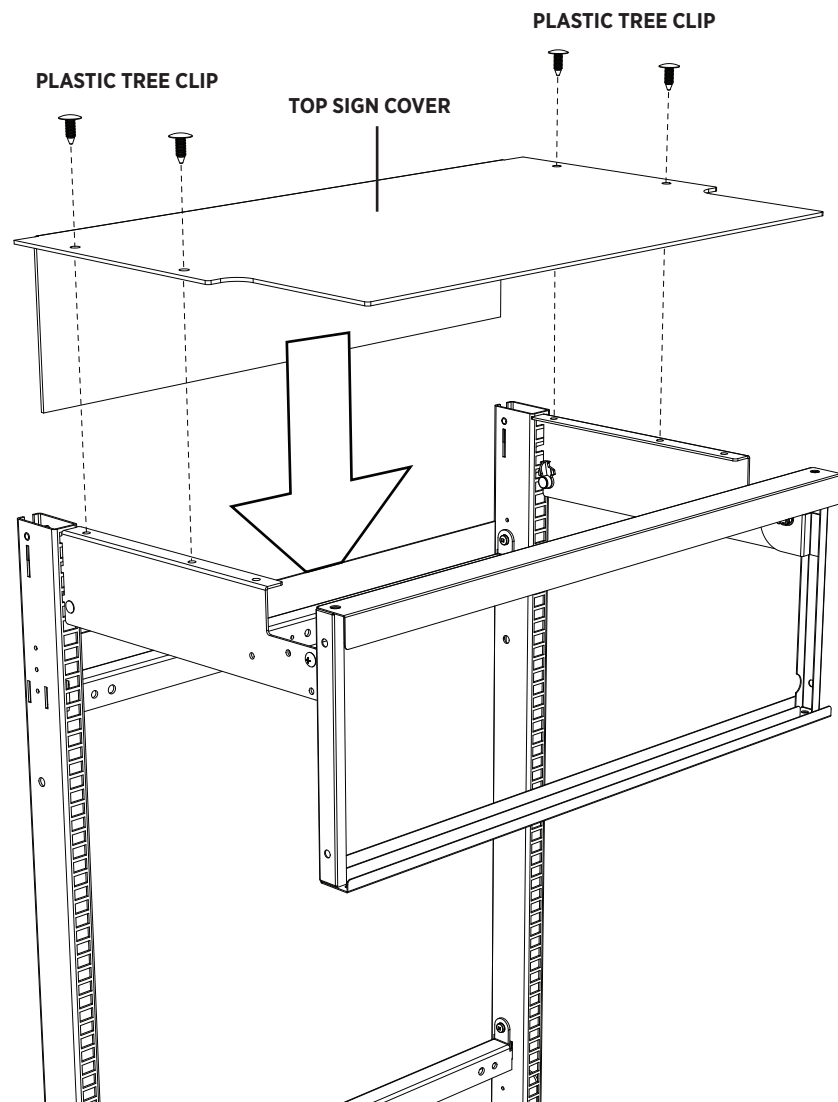


Attach Top Sign Structure to Standard Extension.

- Remove Backer Panel and Clear Cover from Top Sign Frame
- Place top hook on the Top Sign Structure hanging bracket into the top slot of Extension uprights (**DETAIL 11A**). Pivot Top Sign downward and engage remaining hooks in slotted uprights (**DETAIL 11B**) and push downward to secure.
- Lock Top Sign Structure into place by engaging both rotating locks into slots in vertical uprights (**DETAIL 11C**).

STEP 12: Attach Top Cover Onto Top Sign Structure

- Align Top Sign Cover over side brackets of Top Sign and lower into place.
- Slide the back panel of Top Sign Cover behind the back panel on Standard Extension.
- Align holes in Top Sign Cover over holes in Top Sign hanging brackets. Install four (4) Plastic Tree Clips.
- Repeat installation for all Top Signs in the set.



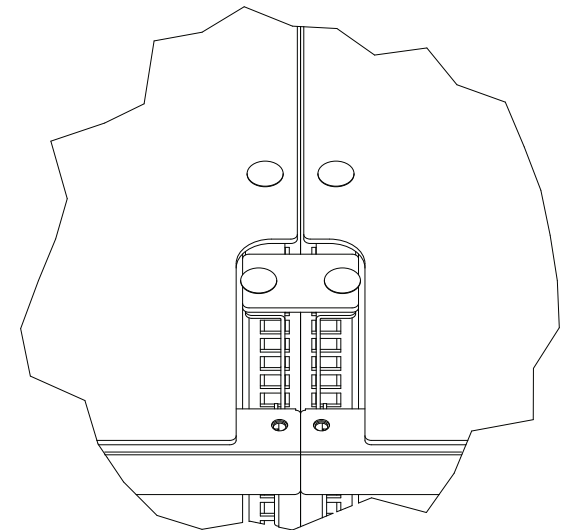
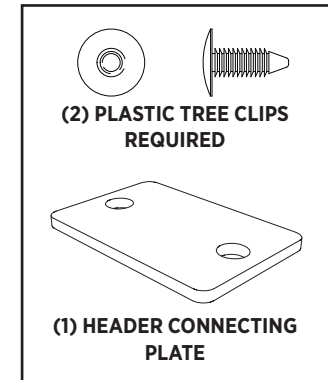
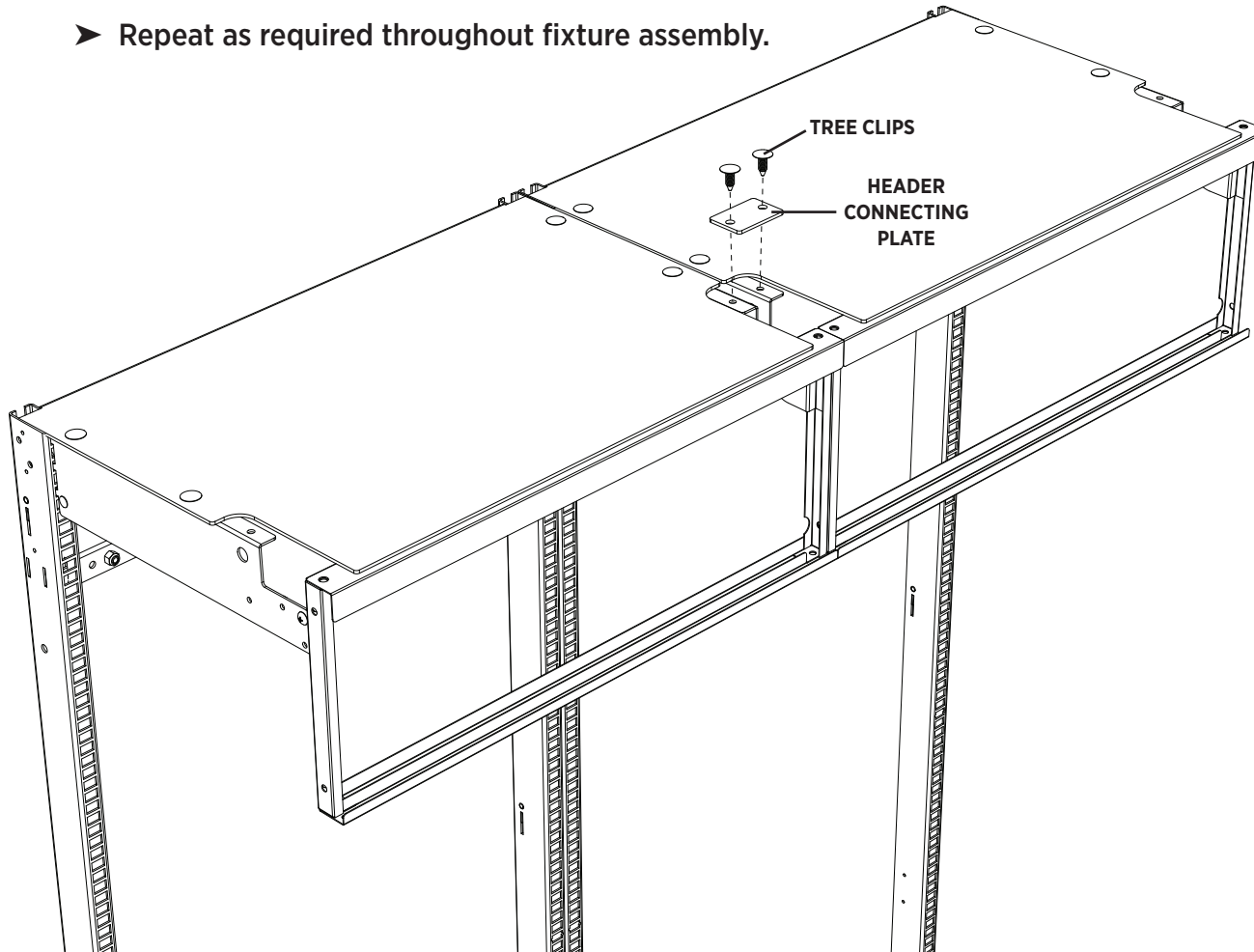

STEP 13: Connect Top Signs Together

Connect Adjacent Top Sign Structures Together For Added Stability.

- Install header connecting plate between adjacent Top Signs. Align holes in connecting plate over front pair of holes on Top Sign brackets, as shown, and install two tree clips to secure. **(DETAIL 13).**
- Repeat as required throughout fixture assembly.



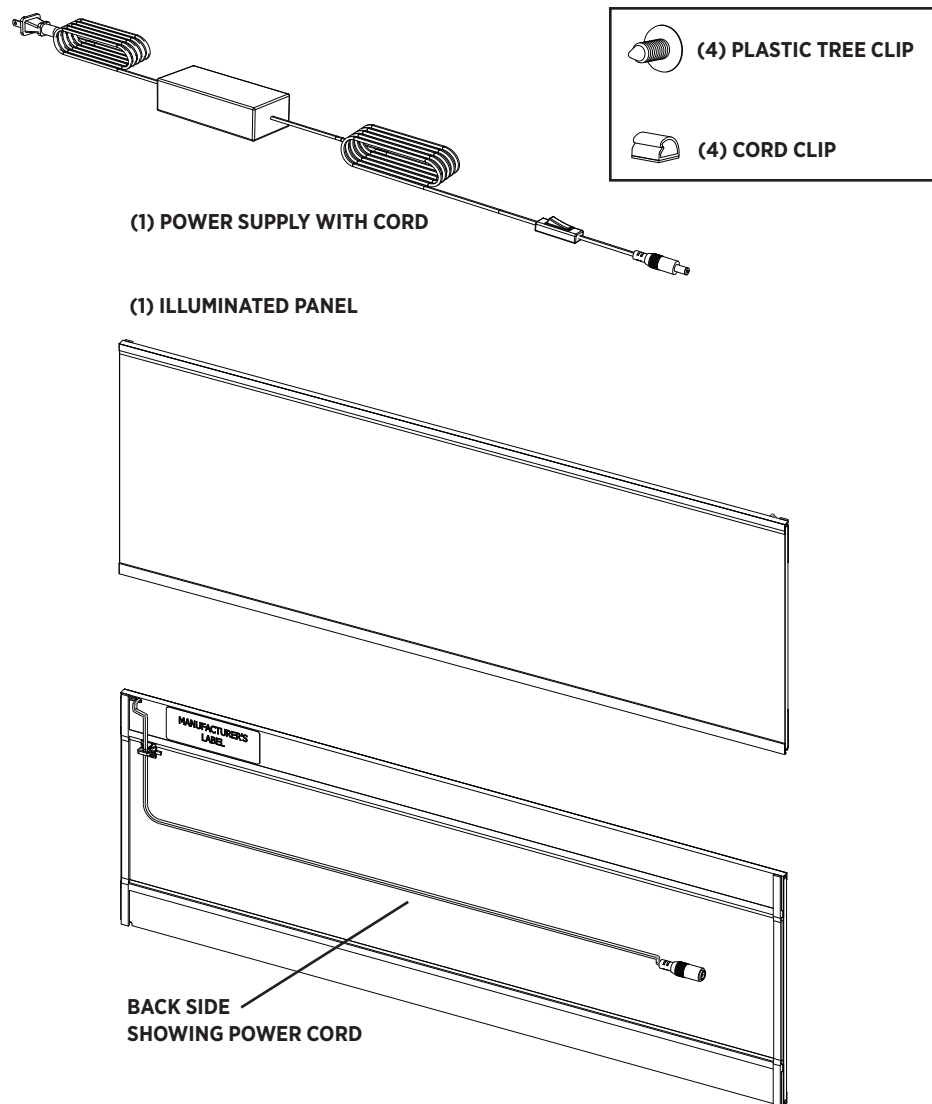

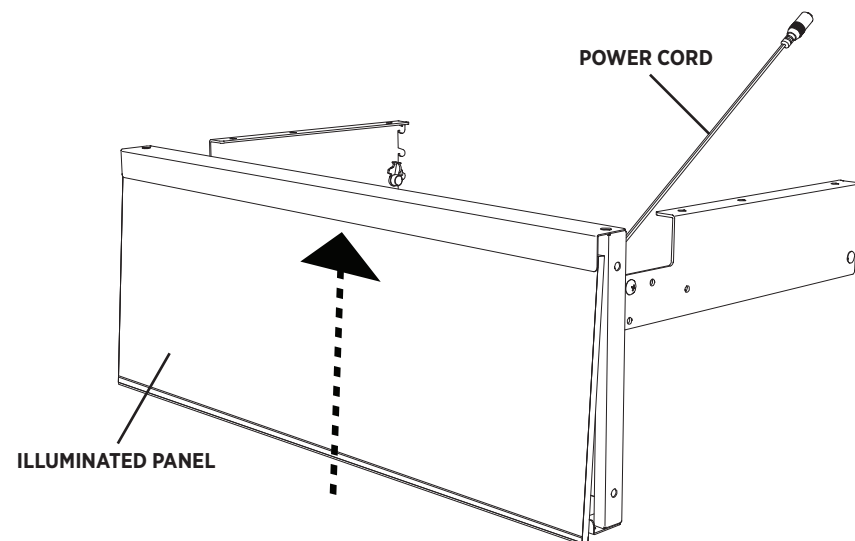

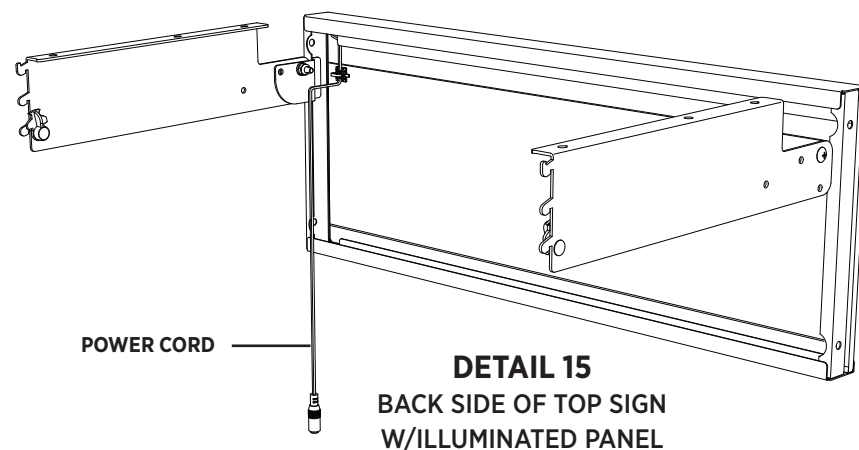

STEP 15: Install Illuminated Top Sign Panel

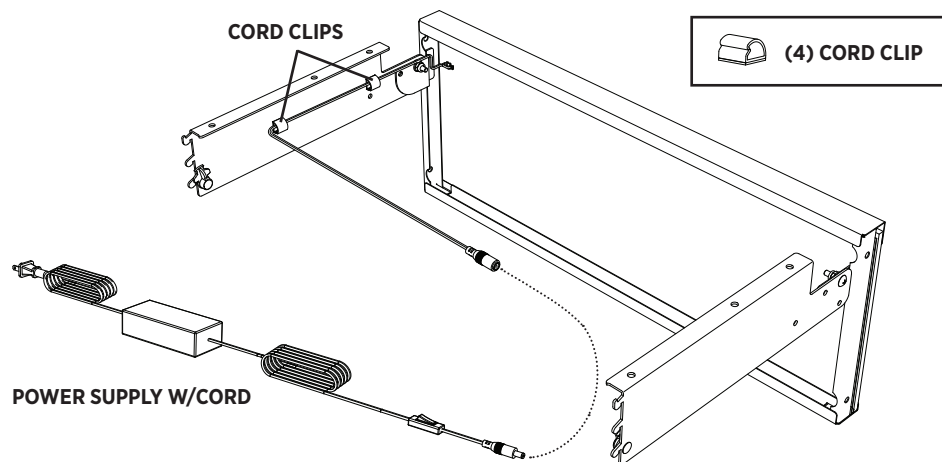


Feed power cord through front of sign frame, then lift and drop Illuminated Panel into Top Sign frame (**DETAIL 15**).



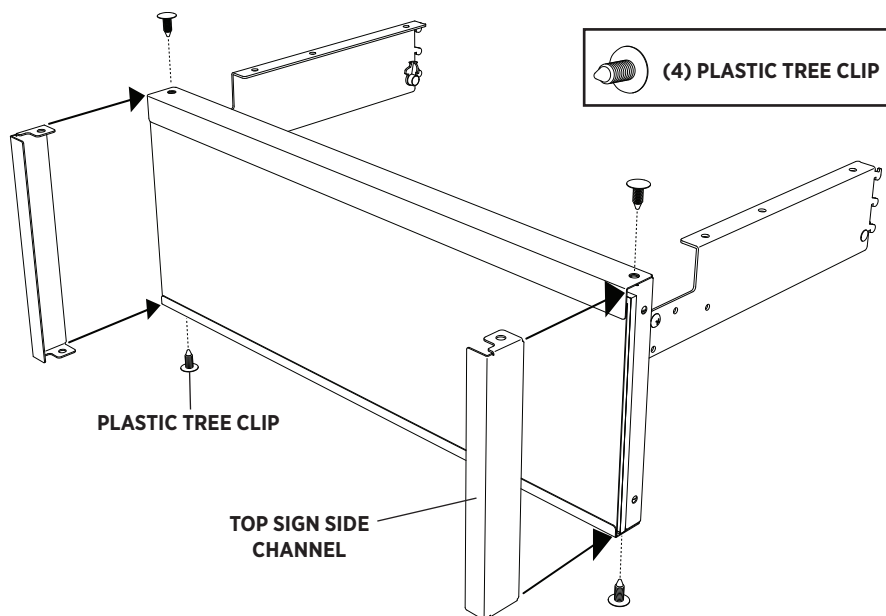

STEP 16: Install Cord Clips And Top Sign Side Channels



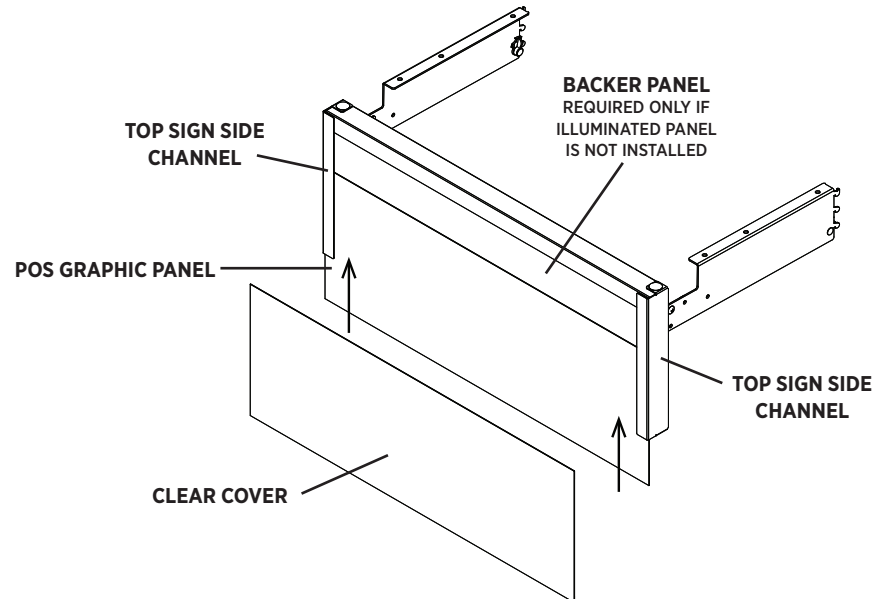
Use supplied Cord Clips to discipline cord on inside face of Top Sign Mounting Bracket. Attach cord to power supply, plug into nearest outlet.

STEP 17: Attach Top Sign Side Channels to Top Sign Frame



Attach two (2) Top Sign Side Channels to Top Sign Frame. Align holes in side channels over holes in Top Sign Frame and install (4) tree clips.

STEP 18: Installation of Panels and POS Graphic



For non-illuminated sets only (when illuminated panel is not used):

- Insert backer panel (removed in Step 11) through bottom opening between side channels of Top Sign Frame.

Slide panel upward until it can be dropped into bottom channel of frame.

For non-illuminated and illuminated sets:

- Install POS graphic (not included) into Top Sign frame by sliding it through bottom opening between side channels of Top Sign Frame, as shown in diagram above.
- Peel protective film from both sides of clear cover and install it into Top Sign frame, in the same manner, so that it covers the POS graphic panel and holds it in place.

STEP 20: Prepare Shelves For Cabinet Storage Assembly

- Two shelves are required to assemble each Storage Cabinet on the Low Profile Base Structure.
- An optional third shelf can be added for additional storage, but it must be installed on the fixture prior to assembly of Storage Cabinet(s).
- Rear Shelf Extrusions must be removed from all shelves used in Storage Cabinet assembly.
- Remove Rear Shelf Extrusion by flexing it toward the front of the shelf to disengage it from metal flange under shelf. Discard after removal.



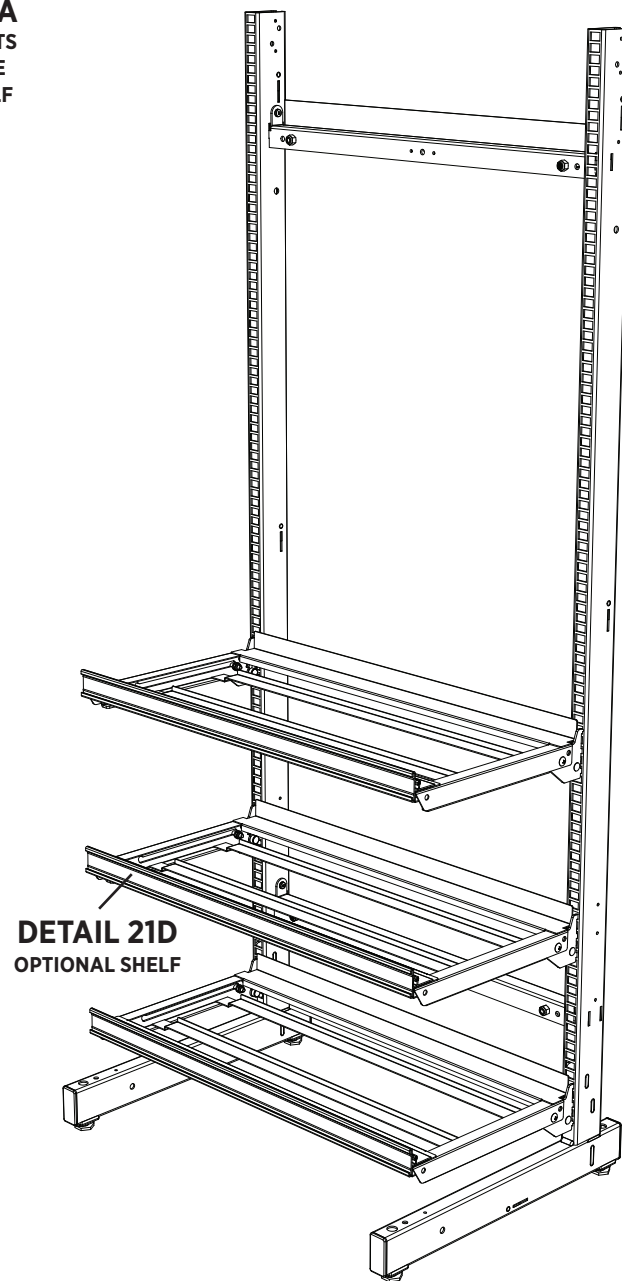
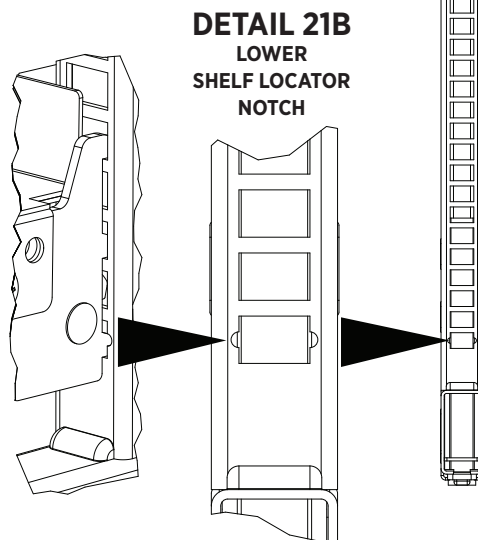
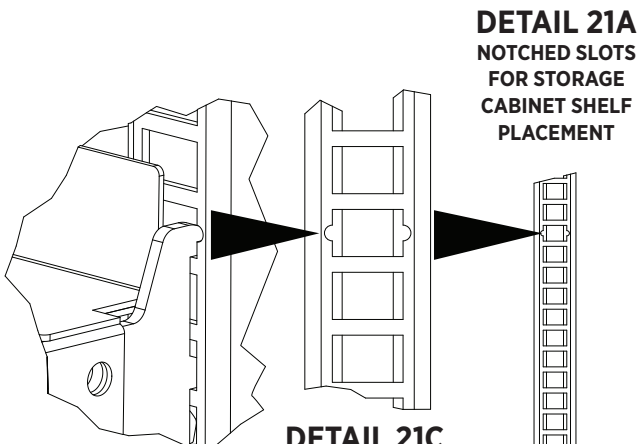
Storage Cabinet Installation - 5.2

STEP 21: Installing Shelves For Cabinet Storage

➤ **IMPORTANT INSTALLATION INFORMATION:**

Install one Storage Cabinet at a time, beginning with shelf installation outlined in this step. Do not proceed with installation of adjacent Storage Cabinets until the first Cabinet is fully assembled.

- Install Cabinet Storage shelves for first Cabinet on fixture. Locate two notched slots in each slotted upright (**DETAIL 21A**). The notches indicate upper and lower shelf placement for quick reference.
- Install the bottom hanging hooks on lower shelf into the bottom notched slots in uprights, as shown at lower right (**DETAIL 21B**).
- Install the top hanging hooks on upper shelf into the top notched slots in uprights, as shown at upper right (**DETAIL 21C**).
- Remember to engage rotating locks on each shelf before proceeding to next shelf.
- An optional shelf can be installed between upper and lower shelves if required (**DETAIL 21D**).

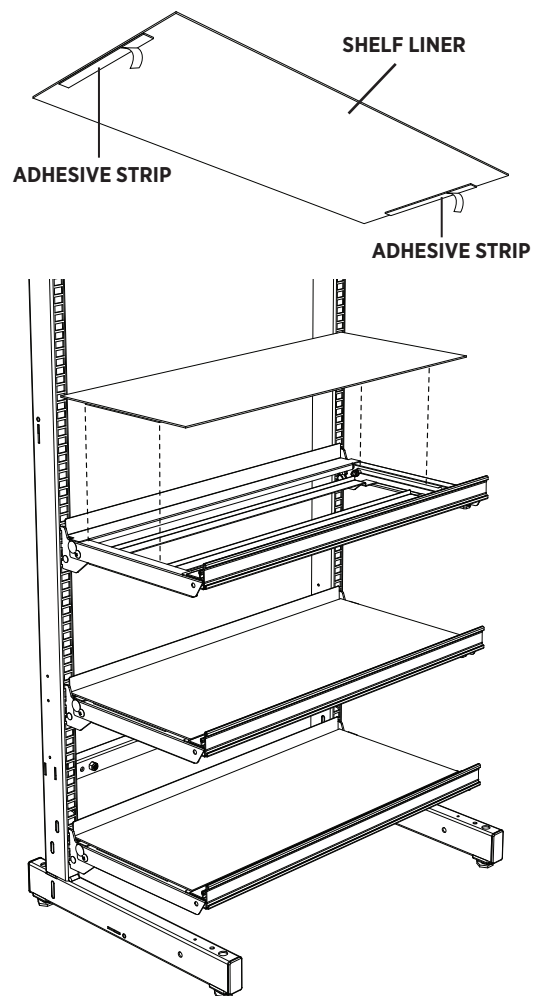

Storage Cabinet Installation - 5.3

STEP 22: Install Shelf Liners On All Storage Cabinet Shelves

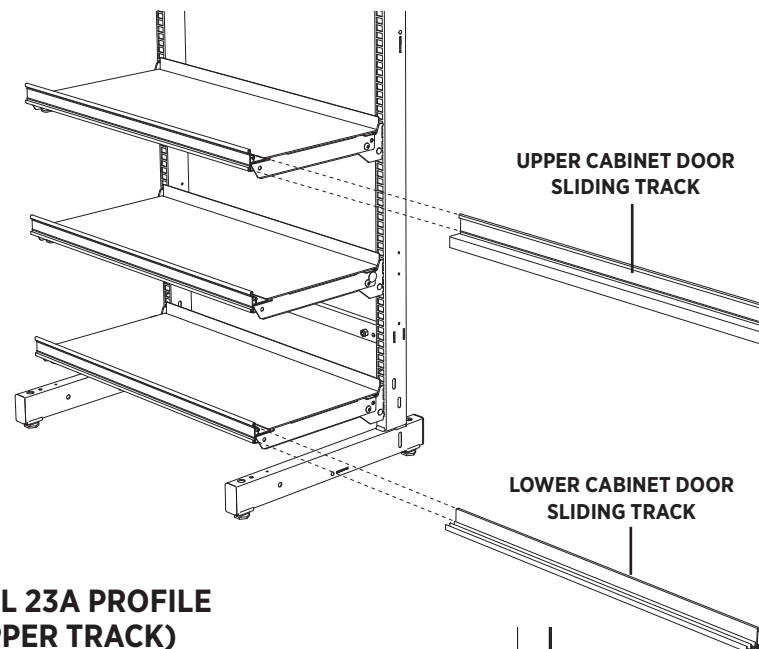
- Remove backing from adhesive strips on underside of Shelf Liner, and align it over sliding tray on shelf.
- Press Shelf Liner into place on shelf tray so adhesive strips make contact and adhere to metal flanges.



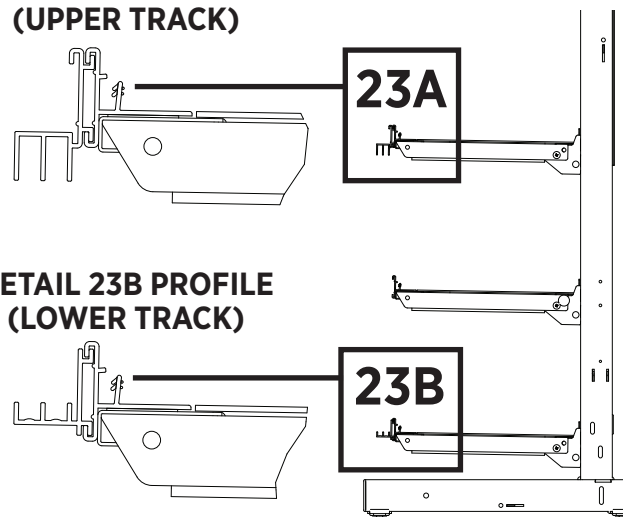

STEP 23: Install Sliding Tracks For Cabinet Storage Doors

- Slide Upper Cabinet Door Sliding Track into channel strip of upper shelf, as shown (DETAIL 23A).
- Slide Lower Cabinet Door Sliding Track into channel strip of bottom shelf, as shown (DETAIL 23B).



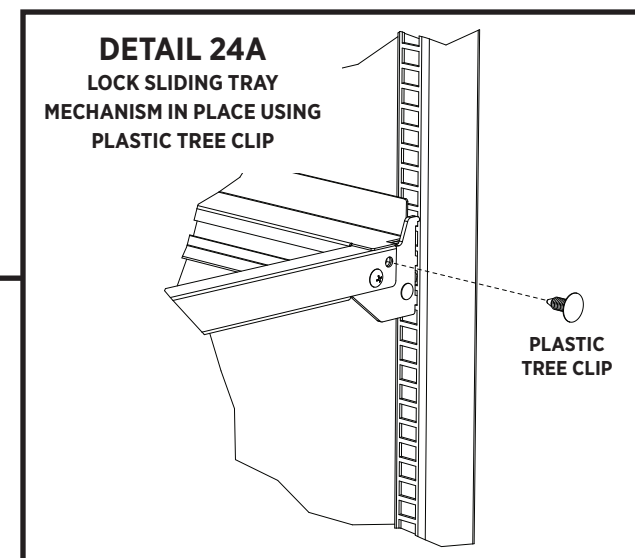
DETAIL 23A PROFILE
(UPPER TRACK)



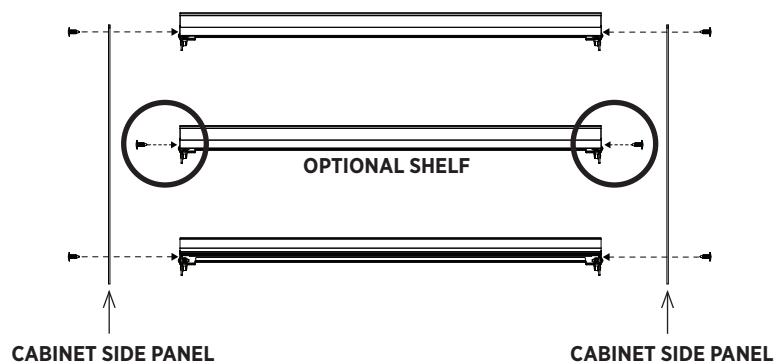
DETAIL 23B PROFILE

STEP 24: Storage Cabinet Installation and Locking Sliding Tray Mechanisms - Planning Guide

- Refer to diagram below for the correct order of locking the sliding tray mechanisms on shelves (using plastic tree clips) during Storage Cabinet installation (**DETAIL 24A**).
- Locations indicated by circles, in diagram below, indicate where plastic tree clips can be installed to lock shelves prior to attachment of Storage Cabinet side panels.
- Work from left to right on fixture assembly, installing shelves for one Storage Cabinet at a time before proceeding to the next (**DETAIL 24B**).
- If an optional shelf is required between the upper and lower shelves, lock the sliding tray mechanism on both sides of shelf prior to attaching shelf to uprights.
- Install left and right side panels of first Storage Cabinet, then proceed to of adjacent cabinets, as shown below. **NOTE: Only one side panel is used between adjacent cabinets.**

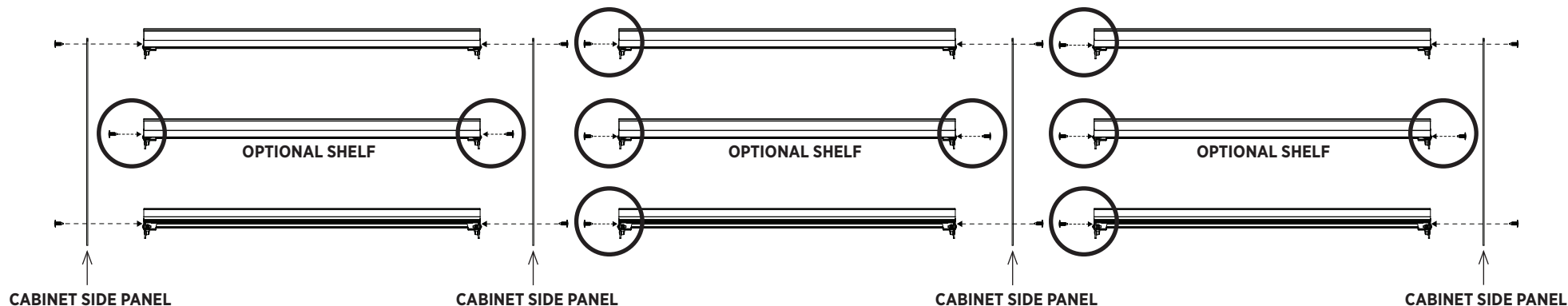


INSTALLATION OF A SINGLE STORAGE CABINET

STORAGE CABINET

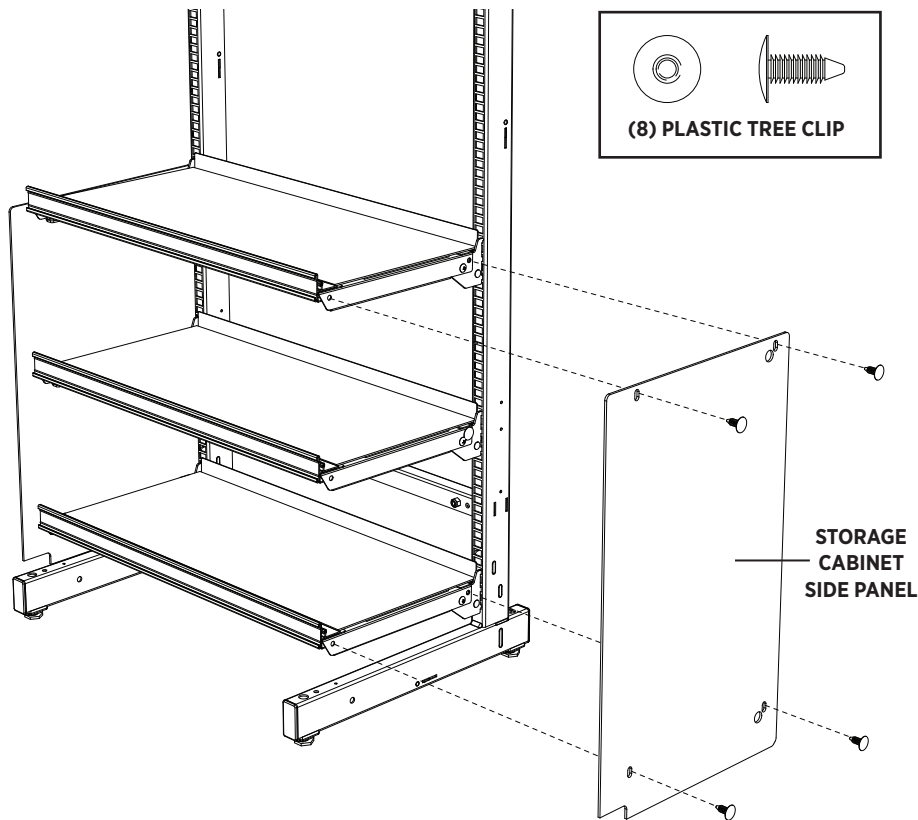

Storage Cabinet Installation - 5.5

STEP 25: Install Storage Cabinet Side Panels

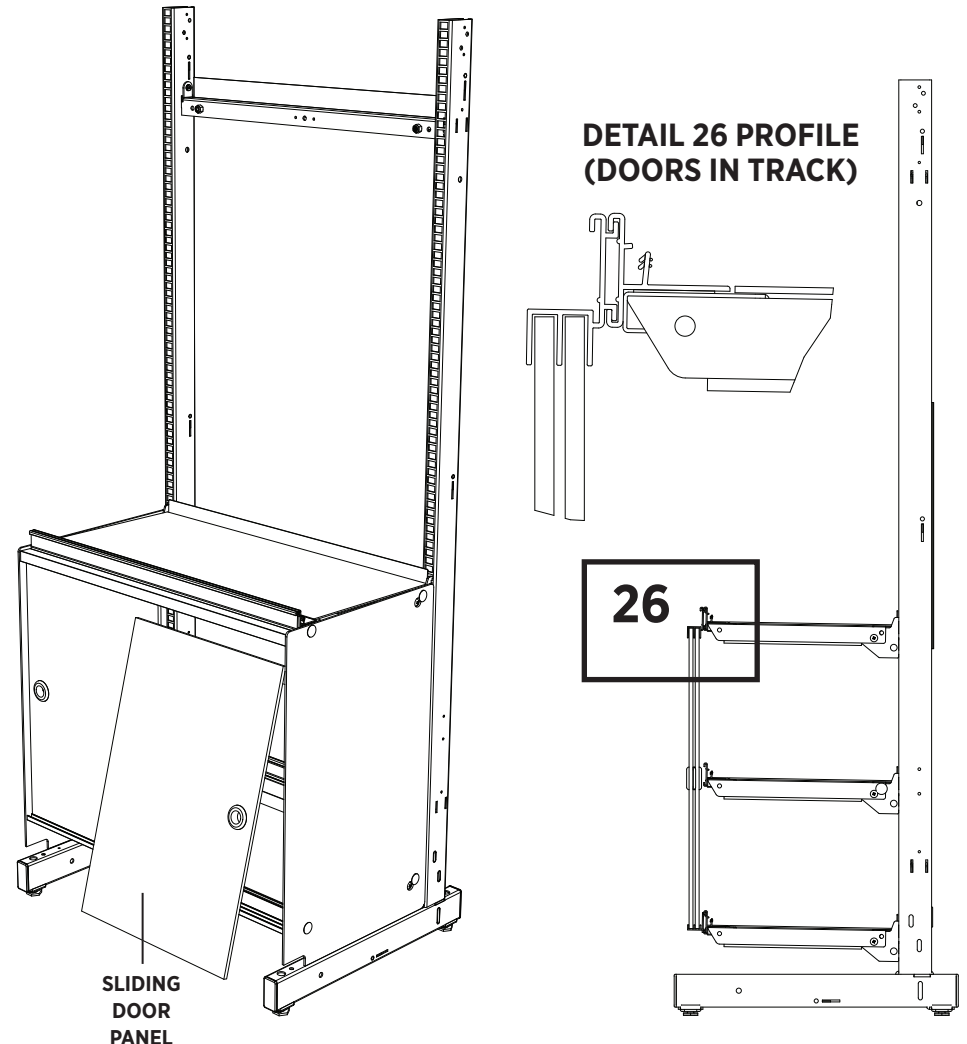
- Align holes in each Cabinet Side Panel with holes on sides of top and bottom shelves and install four (4) plastic tree clips to secure, as shown below.
- Adjacent Storage Cabinets share a single Cabinet Side Panel.
- Refer to Step 24, page 22, as needed for instructions when installing adjacent Storage Cabinets.

STEP 26: Install Storage Cabinet Sliding Doors

- Lift and drop left-side door into rear channel of upper and lower sliding tracks. Lift and drop right-side door into front channel of upper and lower sliding tracks (**DETAIL 26**).
- Repeat STEPS 20-26 until all Storage Cabinets are installed.

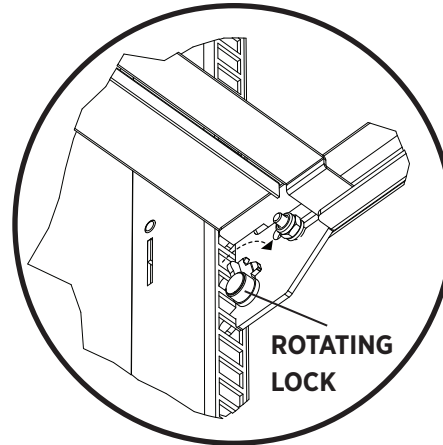


Shelf Installation - 6.1

STEP 27: General Shelf Installation

When Storage Cabinets are not present:

- Start shelf installation at the left end of the set.
- Install first shelf into bottom slots of Low Profile Base Structure Uprights.
- Lock shelf in place by rotating locks into slotted uprights **(DETAIL 27A)**.
- When 6-inch shelf spacing is required, use supplied magnetic shelf positioning brackets to assist with accurate spacing of shelves at 6-inch centers in slotted uprights **(DETAIL 27B)**.
- Install remaining shelves in same manner, per planogram, locking each shelf before proceeding to the next.

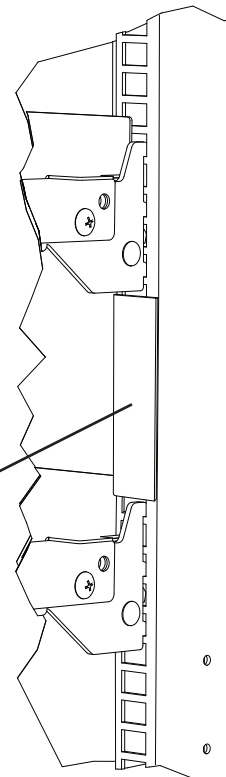

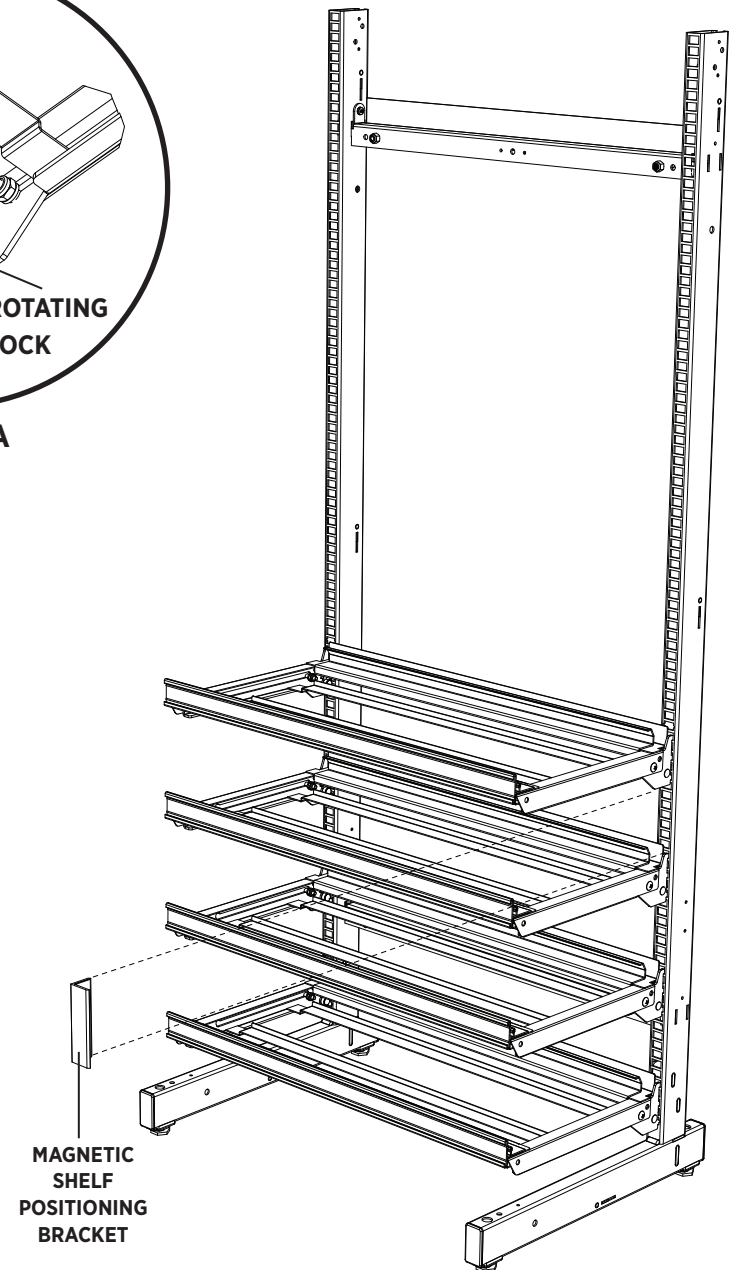
When Storage Cabinets are present:

- Start shelf installation at the left end of the set.
- When 6-inch shelf spacing is required, use supplied magnetic shelf positioning brackets to assist with accurate spacing of shelves at 6-inch centers above top shelf of Storage Cabinet assembly **(DETAIL 27B)**.
- Install remaining shelves in same manner.

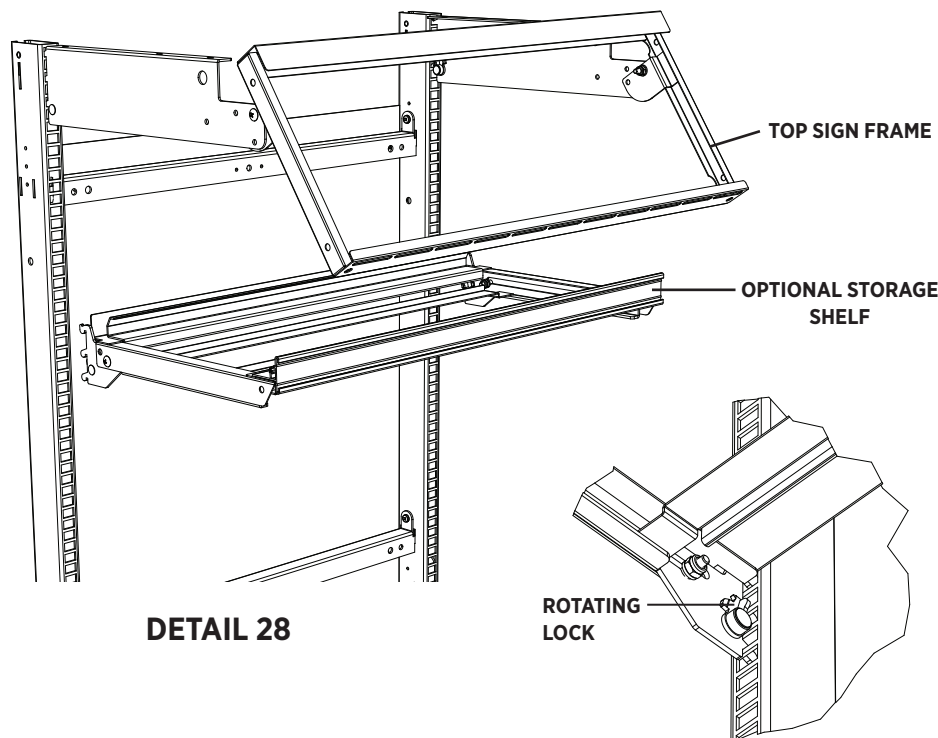

Optional Shelf Installation - 6.2

STEP 28 (OPTIONAL ADD-ON): Install Storage Shelf Behind Top Sign

If desired, an additional shelf can be installed behind the Top Sign to create a concealed storage area. Refer to installation planogram.

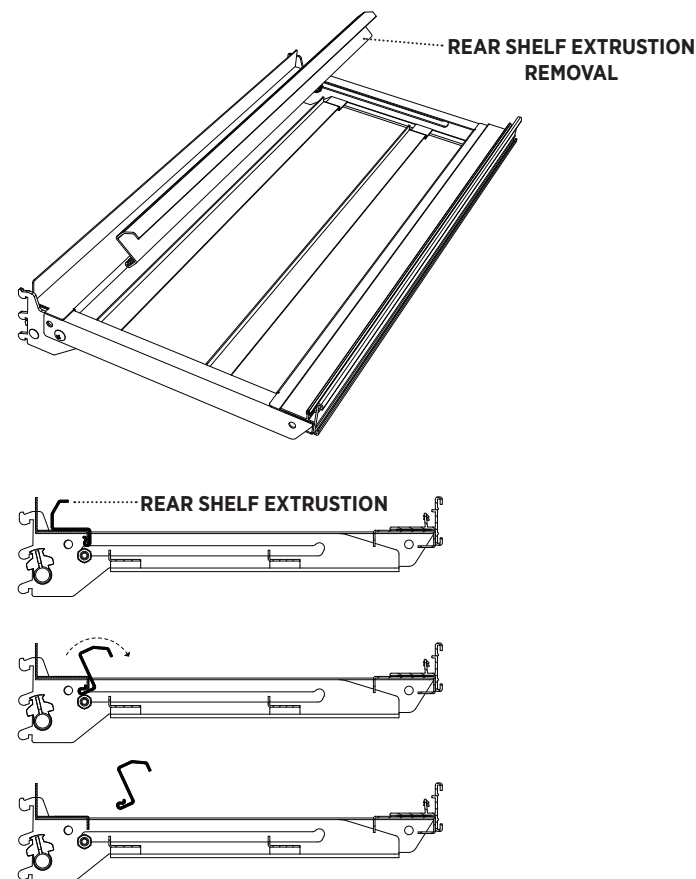
- Pivot Top Sign frame upward to open position (**DETAIL 28**). Align and install shelf so it will be flush with the bottom edge of Top Sign frame when the frame is in closed position.
- Lock shelf in place in slotted uprights by rotating both locks into slots in slotted uprights.
- Repeat as required.

STEP 29 (OPTIONAL ADD-ON): Install Shelf Liner On Storage Shelf

- Refer to installation planogram to determine if a Shelf Liner is required on the optional Storage Shelf installed in Step 28. If so, the Rear Shelf Extrusion must be removed from the shelf.
- Remove Rear Shelf Extrusion by flexing it toward the front of the shelf to disengage it from metal flange under shelf. Discard after removal.
- Refer to Step 22, page 21, for Shelf Liner installation instructions.

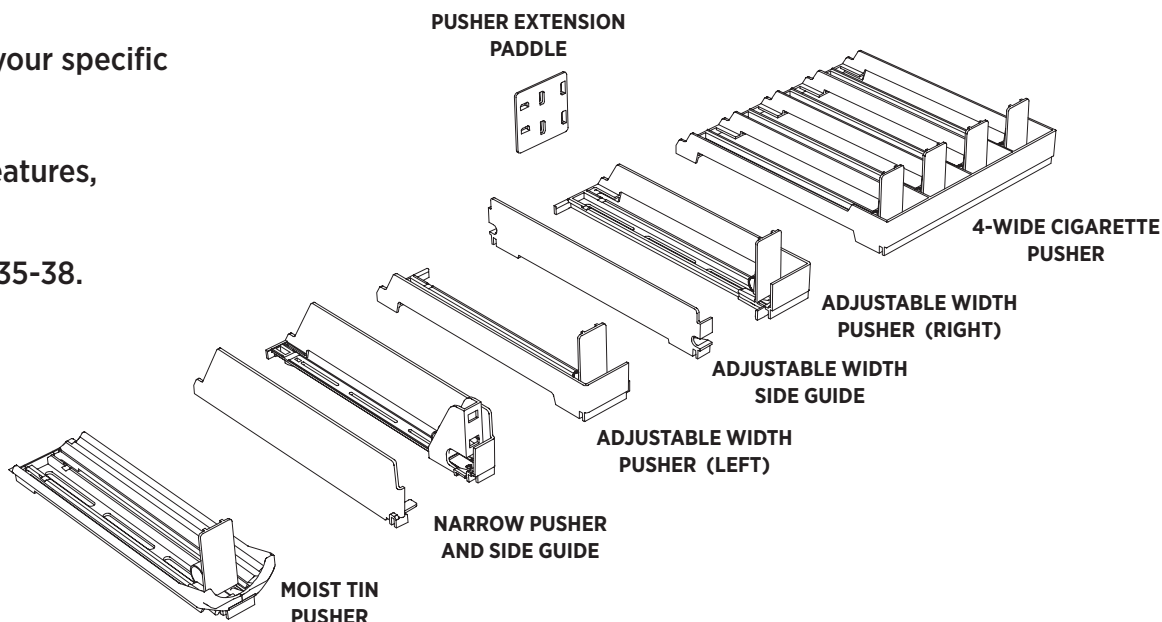


Install Pushers - 7.1

STEP 30: Identify Spring Load Pusher Types

Identify spring load pusher styles and refer to your specific planogram for pusher layouts on shelves.

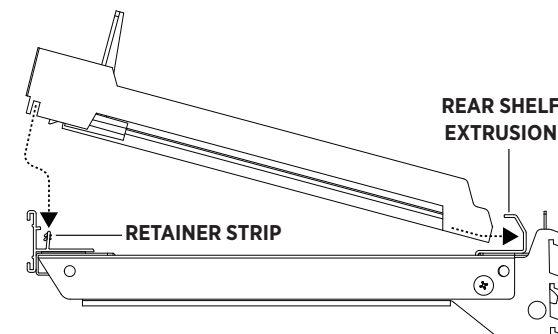
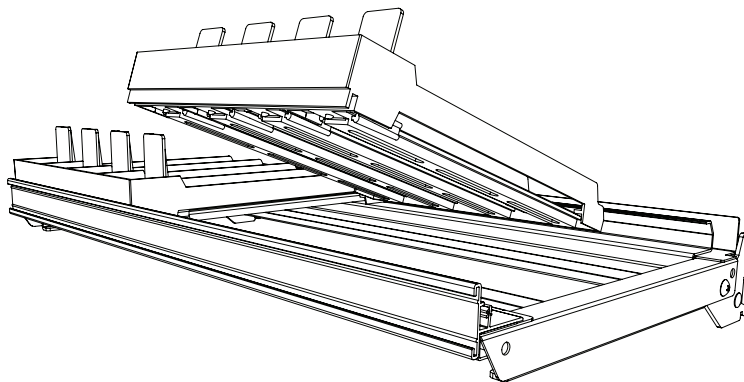
- Review pusher installation and additional features, Steps 31-34.

STEP 31: Attaching Pushers To Shelf

Attach all pushers and side guides to shelves by inserting the back end of each part under the rear shelf extrusion, and aligning the channel at the front end of each part over the protruding leg of the retainer strip.

Press each pusher or side guide firmly into place before proceeding.



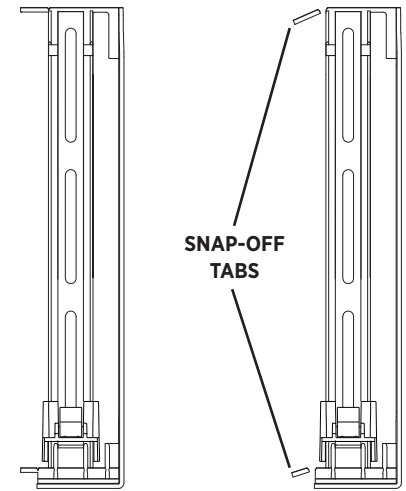
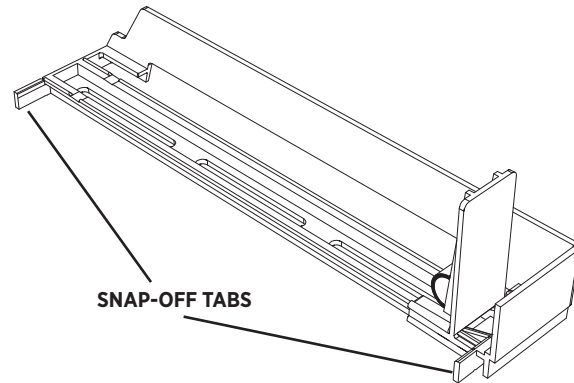

STEP 32: Snap-Off Spacing Tabs On Left And Right Adjustable Width Pushers

Adjustable Width Pushers have snap-off spacing tabs which allow tighter spacing between adjacent pushers to accommodate narrow product packaging.

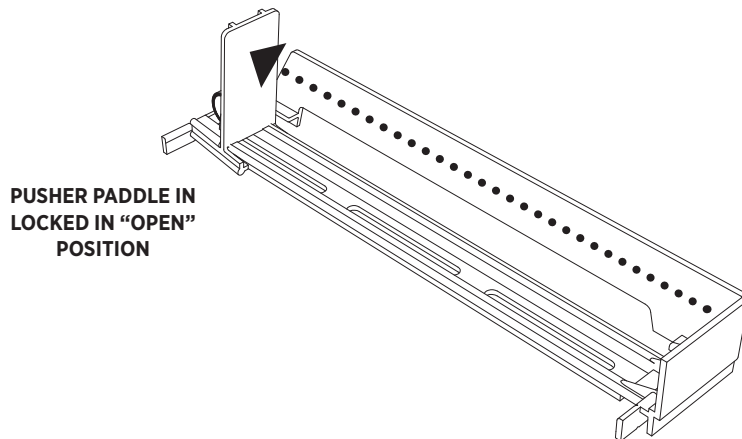
Both front and back spacing tabs must be removed from the pusher cartridge (**DETAIL 32**).

STEP 33: Locking Pusher Paddle Feature

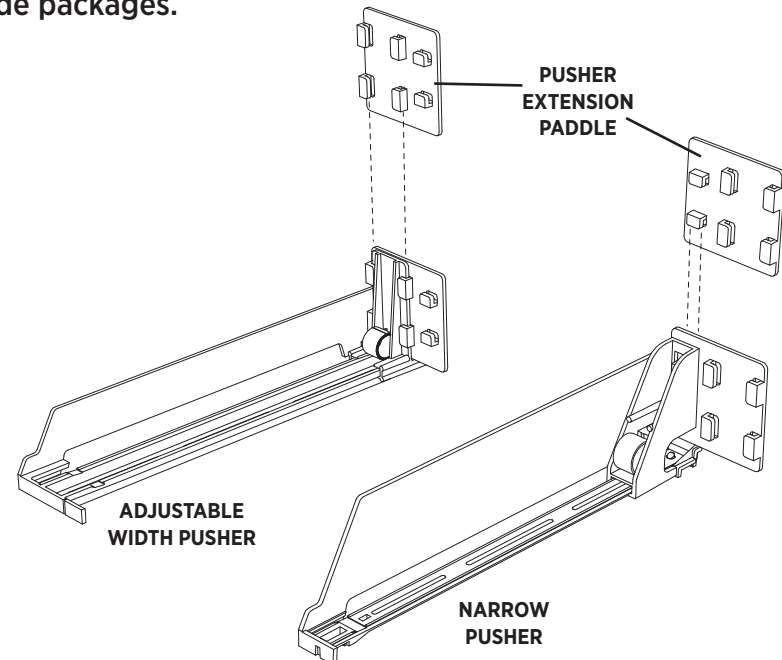

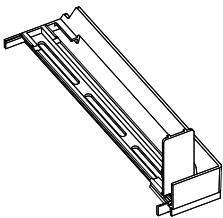
